The 80 wines you'll find profiled on the following pages comprise Fleming's national selections, which are available at all locations. The other 20 are chosen by our local Wine Managers to reflect personal guest preferences, regional tastes and special wine-buying opportunities available only on a limited scale. All these wines have one thing in common: they have met the demanding standards set by Director of Wine Maeve Pesquera during a highly competitive 12-month tasting process.

This year, we are showcasing the most innovative, cutting-edge wines from iconic and classic wineries. Never content to rest on their laurels (or should we say, vine leaves), they are pioneering the latest vineyard techniques, while consistently astonishing us with their quality and character. From small-yield, sustainable, organic and biodynamic farming to the latest in canopy management and hand-harvesting and sorting, our picks are leading the industry into a new age of winemaking. Some of the brightest stars in the California winemaking world are now featured by the glass at Fleming's.

A word about the list itself. While most restaurants simply present their wines alphabetically, or by price or growing region, we insist on a more "user-friendly" approach. The wines of the Fleming's 100 are listed in order of intensity: first whites, then reds, from lightest to fullest, sweetest to driest for the whites, and least to most tannic for the reds. This will help you make the best possible choice for your tastes and your menu selection. Simply put, when you have a perfect match, you have a perfect meal.

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## SPARKLING



### MAS FI, Brut Cava Spain NV

The Romans began growing grapes in Spain over 2000 years ago. The Masachs family has been cultivating vineyards and producing fine Spanish Cava just 25 miles south of Barcelona since the 1920s. From the heart of “El Penedés,” the ancient wine region that breathes Mediterranean air and spreads north to the Montserrat mountain range, this straw-yellow sparkler displays scents of white flowers, ripe fruit and citrus. With fine, persistent bubbles, it offers fresh stone fruit, citrus and pleasant creamy flavors. Caesar would be proud!

### MIONETTO, Extra Dry Prosecco di Valdobbiadene NV

Francesco Mionetto didn't just leave his grandsons a winery. He also left them his longstanding relationships with the vineyard owners of the Valdobbiadene area. These time-fused relationships are what assure that to this day Mionetto gets the region's top quality Prosecco grapes. (Old man Mionetto must have popped a lot of corks and poured plenty of bubbly for one and all.) Straw-colored with brilliant reflections, the wine overflows with classic Charmat-method Prosecco-ness — and fruit flavors of crisp apple and peach.

### SCHRAMSBERG, Blanc de Blancs North Coast, 2007/08

Talk about a storied winery. It's been declared a monument by the California Historical Society. Robert Louis Stevenson wrote about the place in his book *The Silverado Squatters*. President Ford and Queen Elizabeth II once kicked off a state dinner with a toast over a bottle of this Blanc de Blancs (literally, “white from whites”), and Ronald Reagan once served it to Margaret Thatcher. It's been tickling the palates of celebrities, notables and dignitaries for decades. And for good reason: its dry crispness is a perfect counterpoint to its vibrant, fruity flavors.

### DOMAINE CHANDON, Brut étoile Napa-Sonoma Counties NV

The pop! It shoots a smile onto the face of anyone within earshot. Next, this sparkling version of the classic Chardonnay-Pinot Noir blend brings tickling treats to the nose — ginger and spice and everything nice. It follows with a soft, voluptuous entrance on the front palate with flavors of baked apple, honey and cinnamon (like mom's apple pie!). The flavors build and build into a long, lingering, creamy caramel finish. Beautiful with food, the mere act of opening it is cause for celebration.

Blend: 48% Chardonnay, 46% Pinot Noir, 6% Pinot Meunier

### ROEDERER ESTATE, Brut Rosé Anderson Valley NV

Vibrant vines and sparkling wines spring to mind at the mention of the name Roederer, the Napa estate of the French Champagne house that produces the sublime Cristal. This hand-harvested Pinot Noir-based wine is ever so faintly pink, creamy and complex, with bright strawberry and black cherry flavors up front, and a lush mix of cherry and lemon splashing through the fine bubbles. An extra measure of Chardonnay contributes elegance and balance to the fruitiness of the Pinot.

Blend: 60% Pinot Noir, 40% Chardonnay

## WHITE WINES & BLENDS

### RIFF, Pinot Grigio della Venezie Italy, 2010/11

This winery, started in 1823, is tucked up in the southern part of the Alto Adige appellation and the northern area of Trentino, just yodeling distance from Austria or Switzerland, depending on which direction you face. It's one of those places where languages and cultures blend into a unique hybrid, like the distinctive sandy igneous and gravelly limestone soil that gives Alois Lageder wines their particular elegance and complexity. With aromas of flowers and spice, and flavors of pineapple and pear laced with smoky notes, this Pinot Grigio echoes in your mind like a call across the mountains.

**BERINGER, White Zinfandel California, 2008/09**

You've got to love a great pink wine. It doesn't apologize. It doesn't make excuses for itself. It simply moves beyond any preconceived notions you may have of its kind, and lavishes you with brilliant flavors and aromas — fresh raspberry, citrus and melon. It pairs beautifully with all kinds of foods, and keeps its head held high. 100% Zinfandel *Biodynamic/Sustainable*

**LOOSEN BROS., Riesling Mosel Dr. L Germany, 2010/11**

"I want to taste the depth of the old vines. I want to experience the character of the vintage. I want authenticity; without it, a wine is simply another beverage." These are the words of winemaker Ernst Loosen. He and his brother Thomas created this elegant and vibrant Riesling, evoking the steep, slate-soil vineyards of the Mosel Valley. Aromas of luscious pear, peach and apples burst forward in the nose, making way for refreshing and juicy flavors of pear, apricot, lime and mango.

**PACO & LOLA, Albariño Rias Baixas Spain, 2009/10**

Classic winemaking meets contemporary Spanish style. From the rooftop lounges of Madrid, to the avant-garde restaurants of Barcelona, and the chic bars of Ibiza, Paco & Lola's seductive mix of style and quality captures the flavors and spirit of modern Spain. A beautiful straw-yellow wine, this Albariño leads with notes of citrus, green apples, herbs and flowers on the nose. The fresh fruit flavors are balanced with a lively acidity that makes for a pleasurable and crisp finish that is wonderful when paired with poultry, pork and veal.

**ZILLIKEN, Riesling Medium-Dry Mosel Butterfly Germany, 2008/09**



In Saarburg, a picturesque medieval town in Germany, the Zilliken family has been making Riesling wines for 260 years. Glowing and fresh as the sky on a late spring evening, this wine makes a great aperitif. A lovely nose of pear and cassis introduces flavors of white peach, orange and lemon. Light but creamy, its tart and clean finish lingers in your mouth and tickles the tongue with the lightness of a butterfly's wing — a sensation that inspired its name.

**MASO CANALI, Pinot Grigio Trentino Italy, 2010**



There's a saying in Trentino: "Pane e vino fanno un bel bambino." It means "Bread and wine make a beautiful baby." This gives you a sense of the importance of wine in this region, and the life-enhancing qualities of these grapes — a portion of which local winemakers dry on racks to concentrate the sugar and the flavors. With a brilliant, light gold color and flavors of nectarine and citrus, this wine is as charming as a round-cheeked Italian child.

Blend: 91% Pinot Grigio, 9% Chardonnay

**BOREALIS, Northern Whites, Willamette Valley, 2010**



As unique and extraordinary in the bottle as its namesake lights are in the northern sky, Borealis is composed of four cool climate grape varieties grown in the far north of the Willamette Valley. The aroma practically covers the full fruit spectrum with notes of papaya, quince, yellow apple and hints of grapefruit and lime made all the more exotic with whiffs of jasmine and sandalwood. On the palate it starts with a slightly sweet expression of ripe fruit with a crisp acid balance and evolves to a delicious fresh finish of grapefruit and lime. This is a great wine as an aperitif or paired with a fresh green salad.

Blend: 34% Muller-Thurgau, 13% Riesling, 17% Pinot Gris, 15% Gewurztraminer

### CONUNDRUM, California, 2010

Oh, the problems of being too delicious. Poor Conundrum. Its powerful aromas of honeysuckle and vanilla punctuate core flavors of tropical fruit, herbs, spice and honey, while a lush, creamy mouth-filling texture brings some acidity along for support as it roars through to its beautiful finish. Honestly, the biggest conundrum with this wine is trying to decide whether or not to uncork another bottle.

Blend: Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc, Viognier, Muscat Canelli and Sémillon

### CHATEAU STE. MICHELLE- DR. LOOSEN, Riesling Columbia Valley Eroica 2009/10

A true blending of Old and New World, Eroica is a labor of love between the 200-year-old Dr. Loosen estate in Germany and the premier winery in the state of Washington. For the last ten years, the product of this inspired collaboration is one of the finest Rieslings produced in the U.S. Named for Beethoven's Third Symphony, this dry white wine exudes mandarin orange and sweet lime aromas and flavors with subtle minerality that lends a crisp acidity and a medium long finish. Truly inspiring.

## SAUVIGNON BLANC



### VIÑEDOS TERRANOBLE, Central Valley Chile, 2010/11

Noble earth, indeed! With the Atacama Desert to the north, Patagonia to the south, the Andean Range to the east, and the Pacific Ocean to the west, a Mediterranean climate has blessed Chile's Central Valley with almost perfect conditions for growing grapes, particularly Sauvignon Blanc. Pale lemon green in color, this sublime white shows intensely aromatic notes of lemon citrus, pineapple and fresh cut grass. On the palate, it is brimming with citrus green apple notes along with vibrant acidity and a long finish.

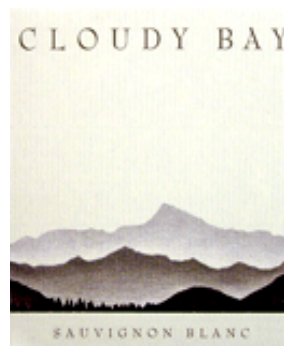
### KIM CRAWFORD, Marlborough New Zealand, 2010/11



Kim Crawford thinks small. Grape-sized, to be precise. His goal is to be there at the moment when the grape is at its peak ripeness, preserve that moment in the bottle, and have it come alive in the glass. Derived from the French words *sauvage* ("wild") and *blanc* ("white"), the Sauvignon Blanc grape comes alive here with a color of straw-green, and aromas of ripe citrus, tropical fruits and New Zealand herbs. With its consistent palate of juicy tropical flavors, this wine has snagged a spot on *Wine Spectator's* Top 100 the past few years.

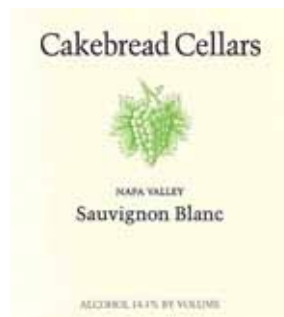
### CLOUDY BAY, Marlborough New Zealand, 2010/11

At the top of New Zealand's South Island, mountains soar, and valleys lay in broad stripes at their feet, crisscrossed by idyllic waterways and dotted by vineyards. Here, the Sauvignon Blanc vines of Cloudy Bay channel the characteristics of their spectacular surroundings. This release earned kudos for its vibrant aromatics, fine structure and layers of pure fruit flavors. With its scents of grapefruit, orange zest, mango and a sweet green fruit character, the pleasures of Cloudy Bay are, well, clear.

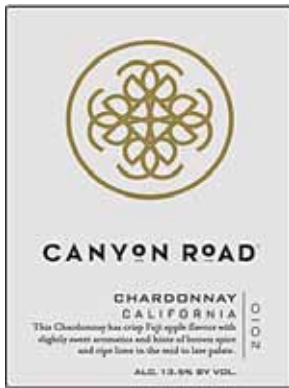
### CAKEBREAD, Napa Valley, 2009/10



One of the true pioneers in Napa Valley, the Cakebread family has been producing superb wines since 1973. They sourced the majority of grapes for this remarkable white from their own Napa vineyards in Rutherford, Calistoga and Carneros. It displays bright, sun-kissed aromas of fresh guava, grapefruit, lime and mineral, with hints of honeydew melon and golden apple. On the sprightly palate, brisk white grapefruit, guava, melon and lemon-lime flavors display a mouthwatering verve, with hints of pineapple and kiwi fruit on the long, refreshing finish.

Blend: 91% Sauvignon Blanc, 5% Sémillon, 4% Sauvignon Musqué

**CANYON ROAD, California, 2010/11**

Inspired by the scenic roads that wander through California's stunning wine country, this is the wine to take on a summer excursion with the convertible top down. This friendly Chardonnay has wonderfully fresh aromas of ripe green apple and citrus. The mouthfeel is creamy and rich yet refreshing, giving way to notes of vanilla, Meyer lemon, and tropical fruit flavors. Road trip!

**VILLA MARIA, Marlborough Unoaked New Zealand, 2009/10**

Selected as one of the Top 50 wine producers in the world by *Wine Spectator* magazine, family-owned Villa Maria has been the most awarded winery in New Zealand over the last 30 years. Crafted in a Chablis fruit-driven style full of ripe peach and stone-fruit flavors, this bright white is finely balanced with just an edge of minerality.

**MERRYVALE, Napa Valley Starmont, 2009/10**

Made from the hand-selected jewels of vineyards throughout Napa Valley, including the Oak Knolls District and Carneros, here's a Chardonnay that truly shines. It's aged in oak for 9 months sur lie (on top of spent yeast... sometimes we wonder how these techniques were ever discovered) to round out the texture and enhance complexity — while still delivering a great big mouthful of lip-smacking fruit.

**EVENING LAND, Blue Label Arroyo Grande Valley, 2009/10**

With hearts in Burgundy but feet planted firmly in the great coastal wine regions of America's West Coast, Evening Land has crafted this Burgundy-style Chardonnay entirely from the great Talley estate in Central California's Arroyo Grande Valley. A rich golden-yellow color, this sensuous Chard dazzles with aromas and flavors of lemon zest, green apple, and hints of mint and nutmeg. Brilliant!

**JORDAN, Sonoma County, 2009/10**

The Jordan winery began in the early '70s, when fine wine in California was in its very infancy. Back then the model wine estate was in Europe. So Jordan set about to emulate the European traditions of winemaking. Classical architecture, landscaping and gardens reflect the winery's old-country inspiration, complemented by the new cutting-edge winemaking techniques of Sonoma. Richly aromatic with crisp acidity, this is a Chardonnay born of classic techniques and California allure.

**SONOMA-CUTRER, Sonoma Coast Russian River Ranches, 2009**

The Chardonnay grapes of the Russian River Ranches must have done something good in a past life to have been blessed with such perfect growing conditions now. The privileged soil, climate and vintage create a Chardonnay that is a study in elegance and complexity: aromas of baked apple, jasmine and honey balanced with vibrant flavors of green apple, lemon cream, and pineapple. Straightforward at first, then, like an old soul, evolving, developing and finishing gracefully.

### KENDALL-JACKSON, California Vintner's Selection, 2009/10

There is a reason this is the leading selling Chardonnay in America for the last 20 years running. Beautifully integrated tropical flavors such as pineapple, mango, and papaya with citrus notes explode in your mouth. These flavors delicately intertwine with aromas of vanilla and honey to create depth and balance throughout. Robert Parker recommends it as a "remarkable value."

### SILVERADO, Napa Valley, 2008/09

The winery's name comes from the abandoned mining town at the top of the Napa Valley made famous in Robert Louis Stevenson's *The Silverado Squatters*. Today, the land is still "prospected" for wine — the kind of wine that made California famous. Consistent with Silverado's retro-California style, this Chardonnay has aromas of citrus, vanilla, pineapple with floral undertones and a crème brûlée note thanks to a generous helping of oak. A light to medium body with vanilla and apple flavors round out the moderately long finish.

### FRANCISCAN OAKVILLE ESTATE, Napa Valley, 2009/10

From the famed Oakville region in Napa Valley, this venerable winery reaches back over more than three decades of excellence. Committed from the beginning to the artisanal approach of small-lot winemaking, Franciscan Estate vineyards are located in the sweet spots of southern Napa Valley. This rich and round Chardonnay has vibrant aromas of Fuji apple, ripe pear and nectarine with hints of vanilla and hazelnut. Bright pear-apple notes with citrus and honey flavors display rich, crème brûlée highlights that lead to a creamy, lingering finish.

### FESS PARKER, Santa Barbara County, 2009/10

Who knew that Daniel Boone was such a wine aficionado? Well it's our good fortune that when Fess Parker retired from show business, he decided to jump into the wine business. This food-friendly charmer, from one of the most beautiful wine regions in California, tastes of all that is great about Central Coast vineyards in the golden state. Aromas of ripe red apple, pear, pineapple, and white flowers combine with flavors of citrus, Fuji apple, honey and lemon. Pure California.

### A to Z WINEWORKS, Oregon, 2009/10

"Hello, my name is Oregon Pinot," this wine screams. Blended from the fruits of at least sixteen different Oregon Pinot Noir vineyards, A to Z lets the personality of the region's Pinot grapes shape this wine in their own image. Deep, pure and overflowing with berries, it gives you the minerals, the spice and the red and blue berries of its home turf, while negotiating a truce between richness and power.

### VIÑA LEYDA, Central Valley Classic Chile, 2010/11

Just to the west of bustling Santiago lies the lovely Leyda Valley on the western edge of the coastal mountains. Like all the best Pinot Noir from around the globe, the vineyards selected for this easygoing red are situated in a cool-climate growing region. Bright and intense, the fruit-driven bouquet boasts plum, cherry and a soft smokiness, fresh flavors of cherry fruit and spices along with soft, sweet tannins.

### MARK WEST, California, 2009/10

Pinot for the People! This is Mark West's rallying cry. This winery believes that great, affordable Pinot, one that's equally at home on a celebration table as it is on a picnic table, is not a luxury, but a right. And so their revolution has brought us this vintage, worthy of the name California, with its fruity-fruit-fruit aromas and flavor profile — rich cherry pie, raspberry preserves and ripe plum on the nose, and juicy dark red raspberry, fresh cherry pie and cola berry on the palate.

### EVENING LAND, California Blue Label, 2009/10

"The Evening Land" has long been a symbol of the mythical quest for the perfect garden. From ancient Greek mythology to now, it represents romantic adventure that today has led Evening Land Vineyards to the extremes of America's West Coast vineyards. Featuring Pinot Noir sourced from three of California's best AVAs — Santa Rita Hills, Edna Valley and the Sonoma Coast — this wine opens with aromas of fresh red fruits and savory herbs. Flavors of cranberry, pomegranate and Bing cherries lead to a fruit-filled finish. Consider the quest fulfilled.

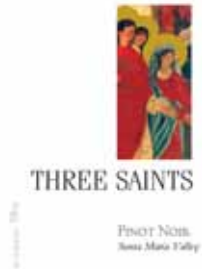

### THREE SAINTS, Santa Maria Valley, 2009

The "Three Saints" represent the three California Central Coast appellations where this family-owned boutique winery has vineyards: Santa Maria Valley, Santa Rita Hills, and the Santa Inez Valley. This delicious Pinot comes entirely from estate-grown grapes in their Santa Maria Valley vineyard, where the cool ocean breezes extend the growing season and allow for more complex flavors to develop while the grapes slowly ripen. Wild strawberry and delicate lilac aromas are framed by green tea leaf, echinacea and goldenseal nuances. Likewise on the palate, a striking savory character balances the fresh strawberry flavors for a more classical, old-world appeal.

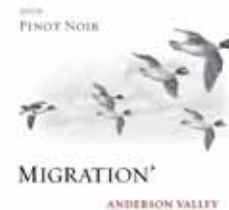

### MIGRATION by DUCKHORN, Anderson Valley, 2008/09

You just might find yourself migrating back to this wine again and again. Like all the specialty labels of Duckhorn Vineyards, Migration has a specific focus and purpose — to explore Pinot Noir from the finest cool-climate winegrowing regions in Napa. This delicious red has all the fruity, spicy goodness you expect from a top-notch Pinot. The nose displays bright cherry, strawberry compote, violet and rhubarb layers, alongside more exotic elements of Asian spice, hickory and earth. These aromatics are echoed on the palate, and further supported by juicy acidity and notes of strawberry, plum, toffee, pie crust and a hint of white pepper.

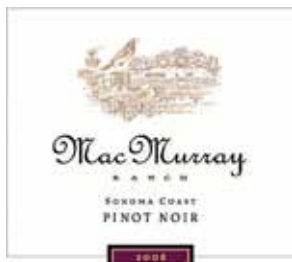


### MACMURRAY RANCH, Sonoma Coast, 2008/09

Remember Fred MacMurray? The single dad in the TV sitcom, *My Three Sons*? This ranch was once his property. Instead of grazing cattle, vines now grace the land, but the wrought iron gate MacMurray made still greets his daughter Kate every day when she comes to work at the winery — reminding us that raising good grapes is like raising good kids — it takes patience and a sense of humor. Aged in American and European oak barrels, bright ruby-colored and redolent with currant and berry flavors, this rich, beautifully finessed Pinot was definitely raised right.

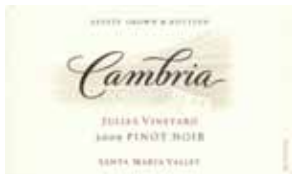
### BELLE GLOS, Sonoma Coast Meiomi, 2009/10

Not everyone can honor their grandmother by distilling the essence of a vineyard into an elegant expression of a California Pinot Noir. But winemaker Joseph Wagner is the grandson of Lorna Belle Glos Wagner, a winemaker herself, and co-founder of Caymus Vineyards. The name of the winery is a tribute to her. This Pinot's spicy aromas and bright berry flavors swirl together in a mix of tradition and innovation. The medium-long finish is an experience to be savored. Mr. Wagner, you've done Grandma proud.

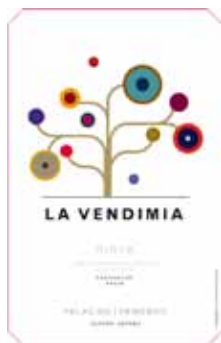




### CAMBRIA, Santa Maria Valley Julia's Vineyard, 2008/09

A three-hour drive north of the glitter and bustle of Los Angeles lie the golden hills and sun-drenched vineyards of the Santa Maria Valley. Pinot Noir grapes thrive in the unique soils and cool, maritime microclimate of this distinctive estate vineyard, named for owner Barbara Banké's youngest daughter. This enticing red has aromas of ripe cherry, strawberry, cranberry and fresh blueberry fruit. On the palate, red fruit, vanilla, and cinnamon are balanced with subtle earthy flavors and a long, silky finish.

## RED WINES & BLENDS



### PALACIOS-REMONDO, Rioja La Vendimia Spain, 2009/10

Spain's Rioja region has been producing wine since the 16th century, when Spain was the most powerful country in Europe, experiencing its most artistically prolific period. Made by Spain's celebrated winemaker, Alvaro Palacios, this red wine layers plum and lavender aromas with flavors of fruit and a hint of wild fennel, allowing you to channel the nation's aesthetic sensitivity, past and present.

### TIAMO, Chianti Italy, 2009/10

Italians believe Sangiovese's name is derived from *sanguis Jovis* meaning "the blood of Jove (Jupiter)" and its beginnings are thought to predate Roman times. A wine must be at least 80% Sangiovese to be classified as Chianti. Intensely ruby-red in color with garnet tones around the edges, this Tuscan beauty has aromas of red and black fruit with hints of cassis and spice. Lush and full in the mouth with good acidity and balanced tannins, this is a wine Jupiter would gladly imbibe.  
Blend: 90% Sangiovese, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon Organic



### MASI, Veneto Campofiorin Italy, 2007/08

A wine by any other name...In Northern Italy, just to the west of Venice, along the foothills of the Southern Alps, lies Verona (of *Romeo and Juliet* fame) and Masi Winery. Masi invented a technique called double fermentation for this unique red wine. A portion of each vintage's grapes are dried and pressed and then added to the young juice, resulting in a finished wine of deeper color, more elegant tannins and more complex aromas and flavors. *Delizioso!*

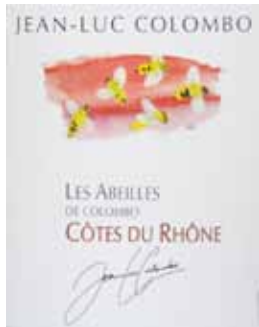
### PASCUAL TOSO, Malbec Mendoza Argentina, 2010/11

In the 1880s, Pascual Toso left his home in Italy and put down his roots in Argentina.
